

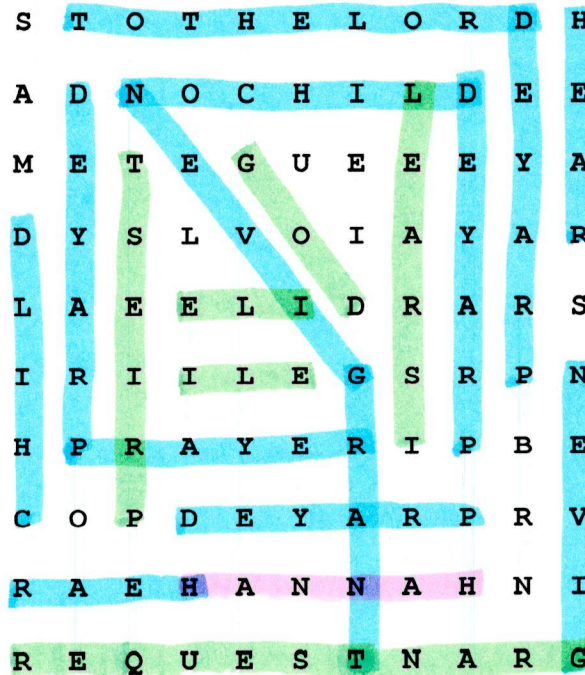
New Style Biblical Word Searches Old Testament Passages

Companioning with Scripture, even in our leisure time, is a blessing. These word searches let you do that. The puzzles have some clues which appear and must be found multiple times, in order to solve the puzzles correctly and reveal a hidden message. This is the "New Style" announced in the book title. You'll enjoy the dimension this adds to solving! Some puzzles are very simple, for novice word searchers. Some are as challenging as anyone could wish.

Each clue word or phrase, *in the exact form requested*, must be found *every time it appears*. You must find all appearances (one for each of the []s following the clue); otherwise the hidden message will be incorrect. Be sure to mark off each clue as you find it. Also, importantly: *no clue is entirely embedded within another clue*. Embedded words cannot be counted as "found" clues. Photocopying the puzzles permits multiple (and repeated) use. Using highlighters is a good idea, so you can see the letters easily after they are "used." And sometimes the colors are called for in order to yield a (suggestion of a) picture, or a design.

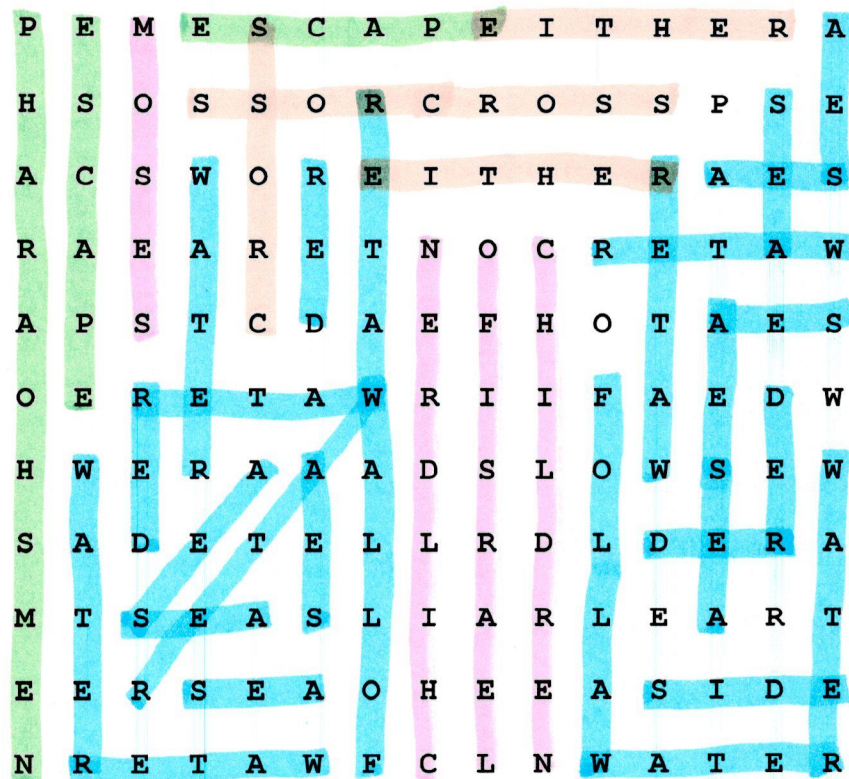

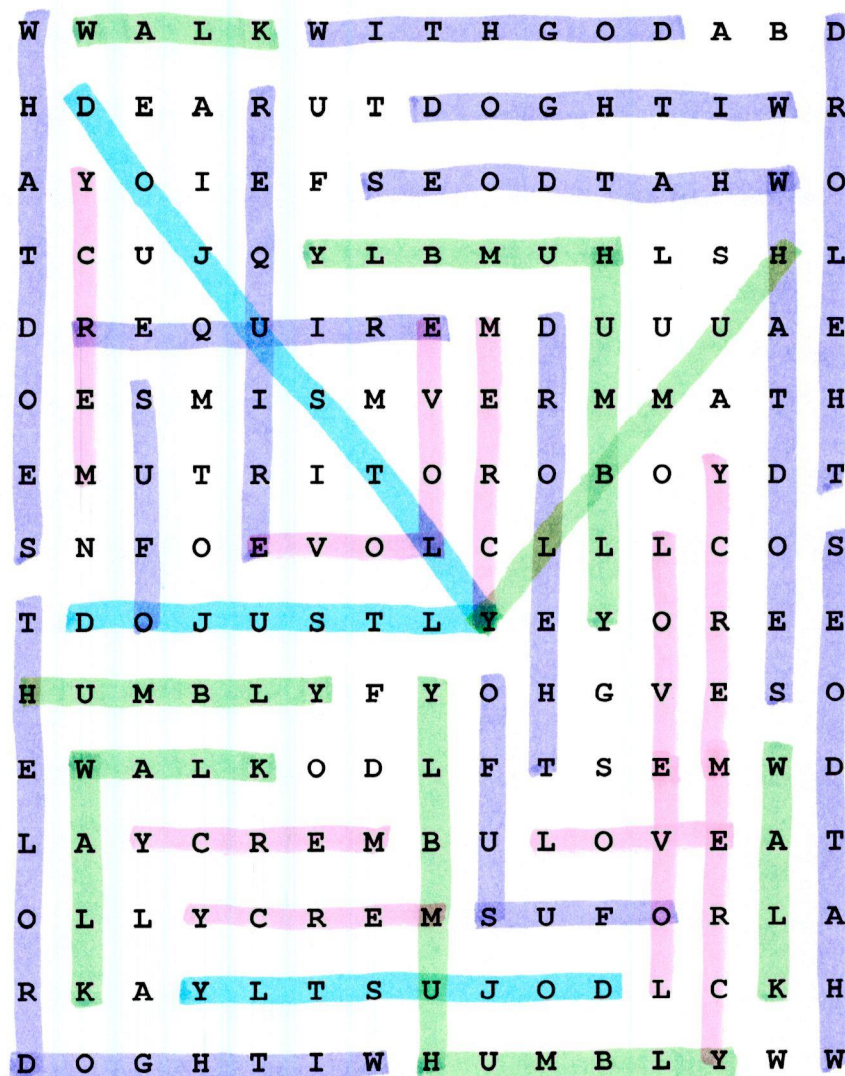
