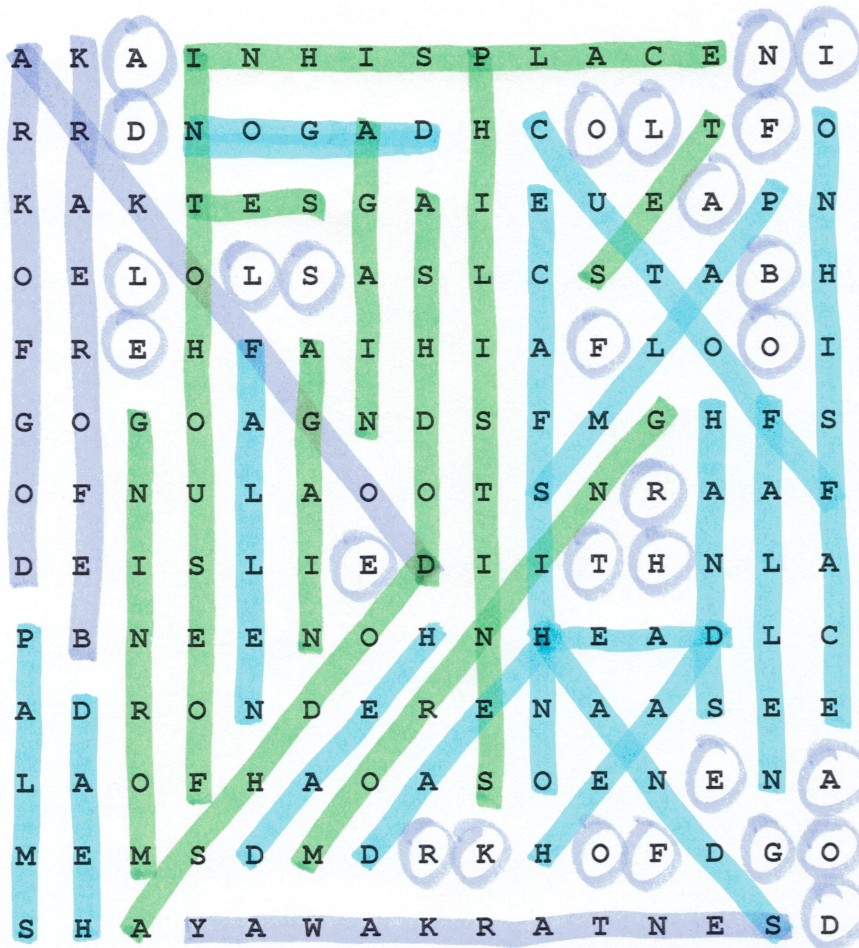

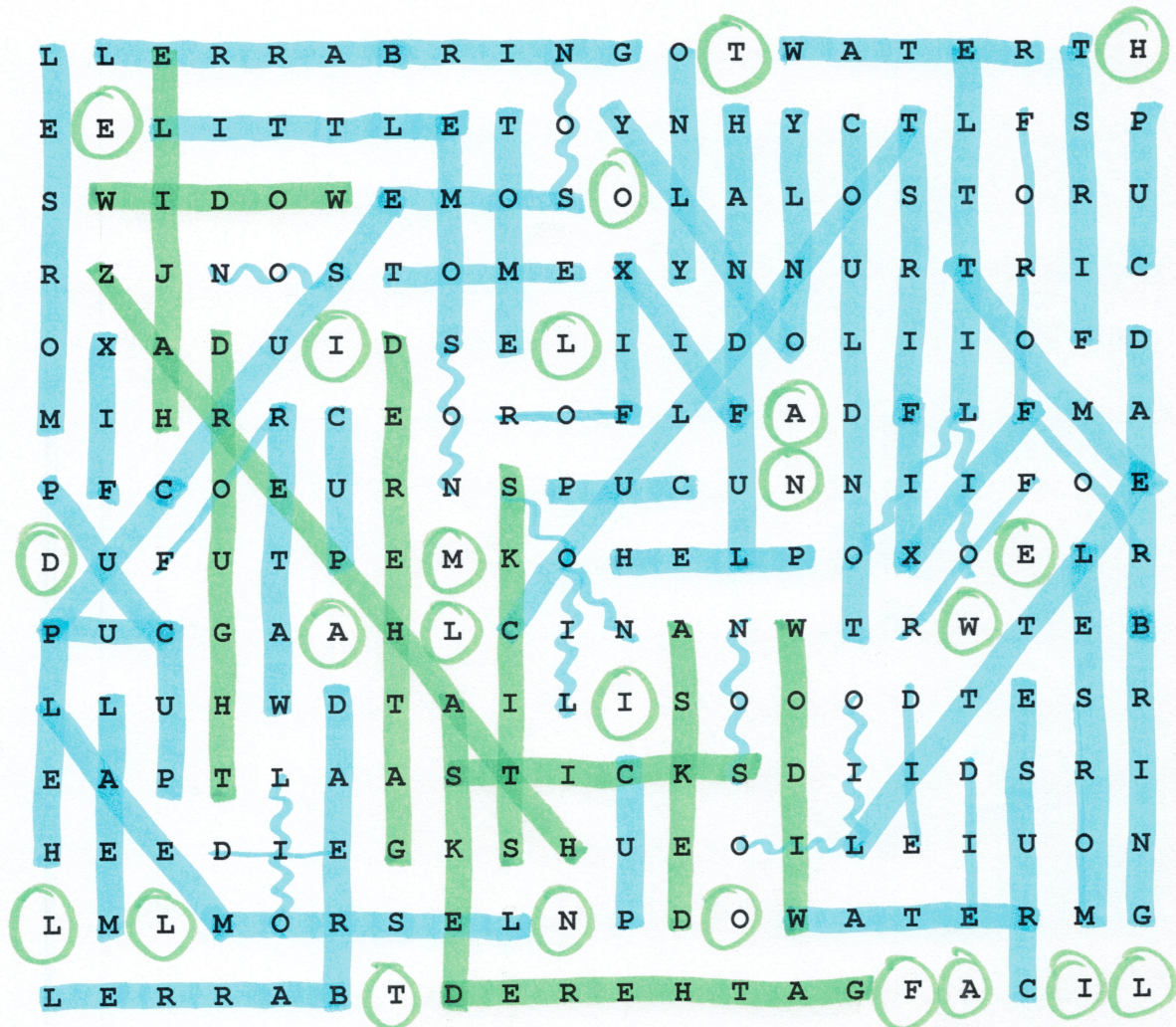

Provision for the Prophet (See 1 Kings 17)

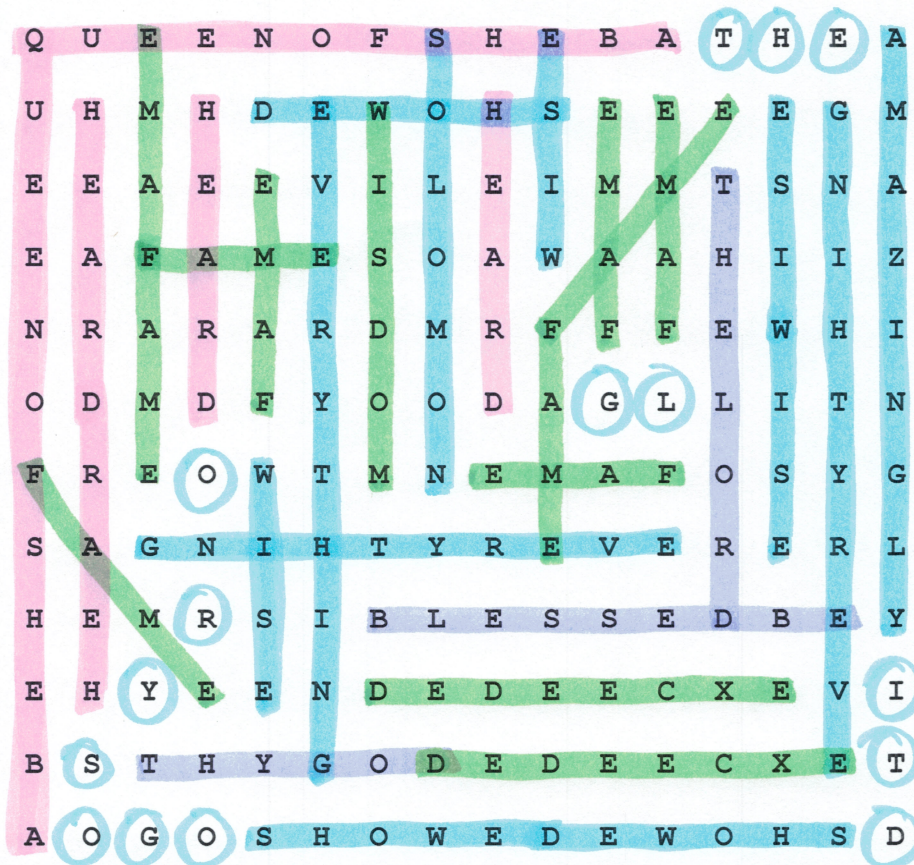

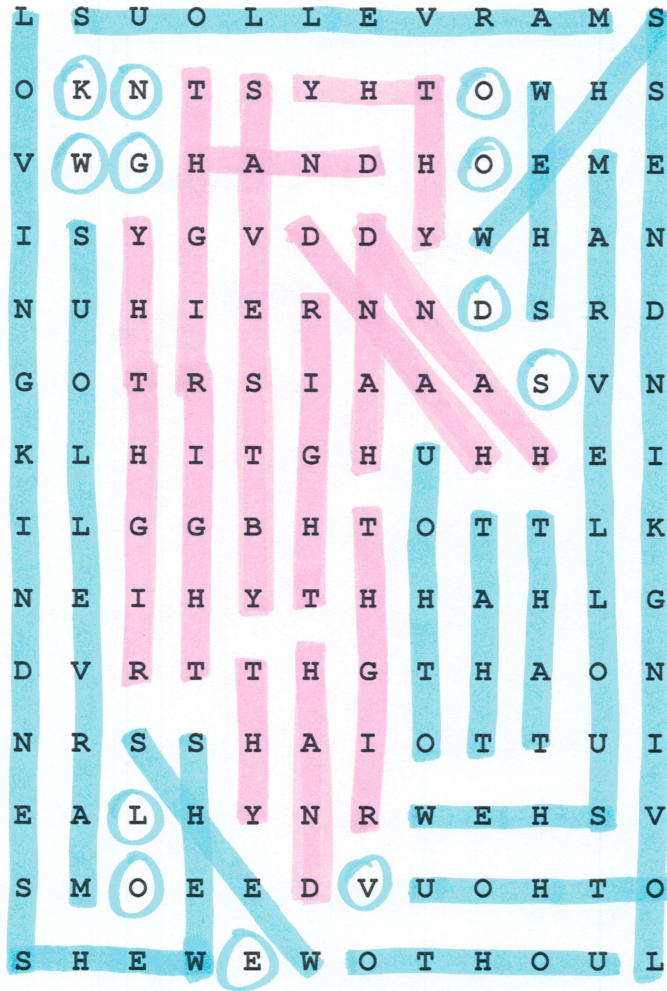
A Wise Monarch (See II Chron. 9) KJV

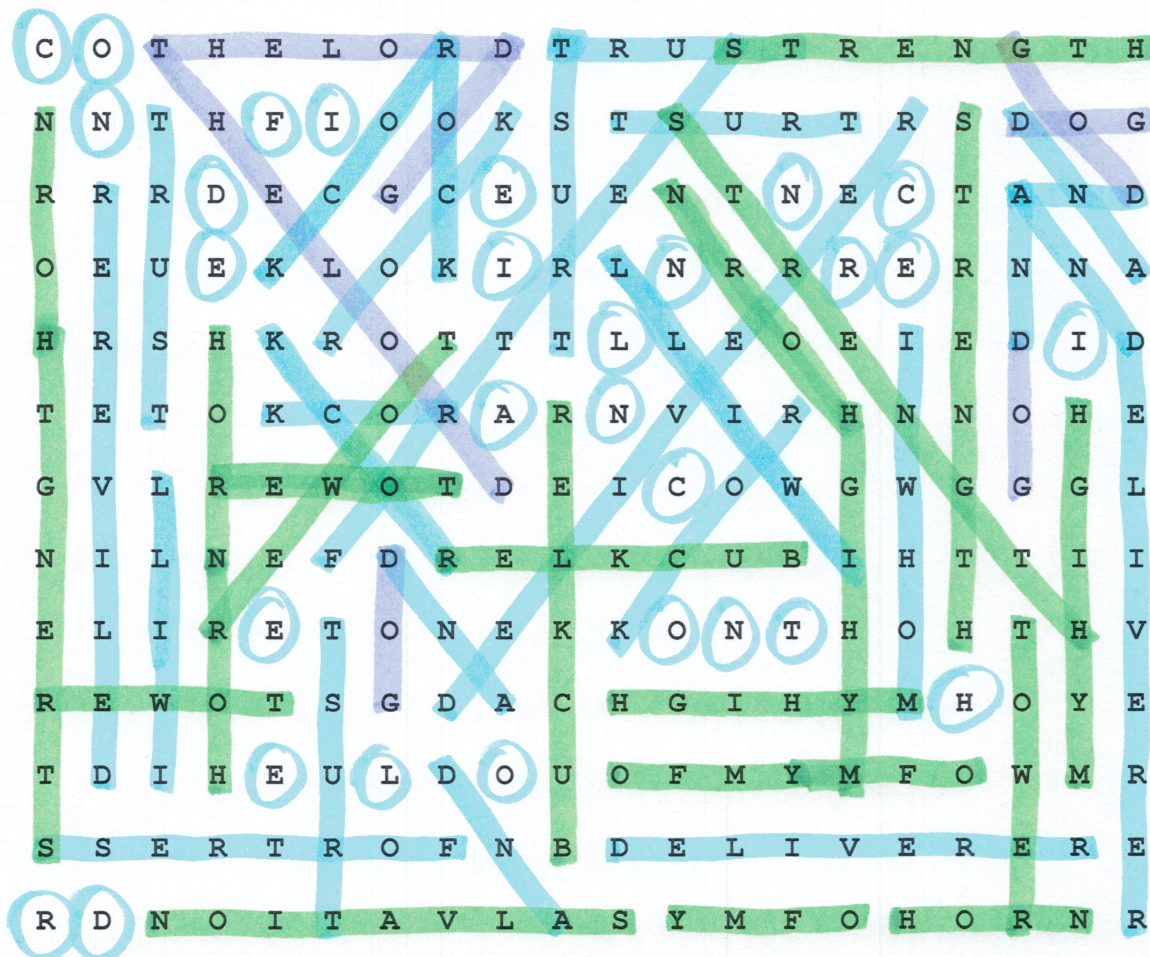

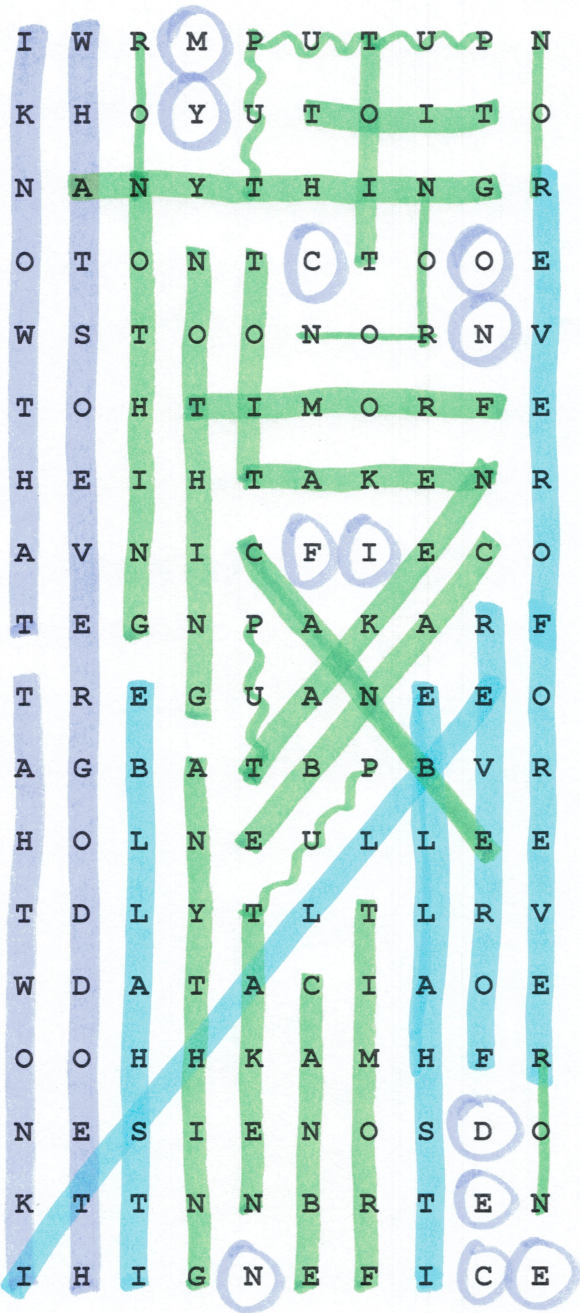
